The Public Service Scholar Program (PSSP) is a year-long internship and academic program for students interested in exploring careers in public service. The program seeks to raise the representation of women, POC, and immigrants in leadership positions.

### Participants receive:

A year-long internship (from September to May) at a wide range of public and nonprofit agencies. PSSP also provides at least one (1) high level environmental internship, A \$2,000 stipend (\*additional funding available for those who demonstrate financial need), Two weekly seminars on public policy, advocacy work, and social and political matters important to New York City, 12 academic credits in Urban Studies toward an undergraduate degree

### To be eligible you must:

- Be an undergraduate student (any major)
- Have an overall GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Be within 45 credits of graduation (upper junior/senior)
- Complete the application and interview process
