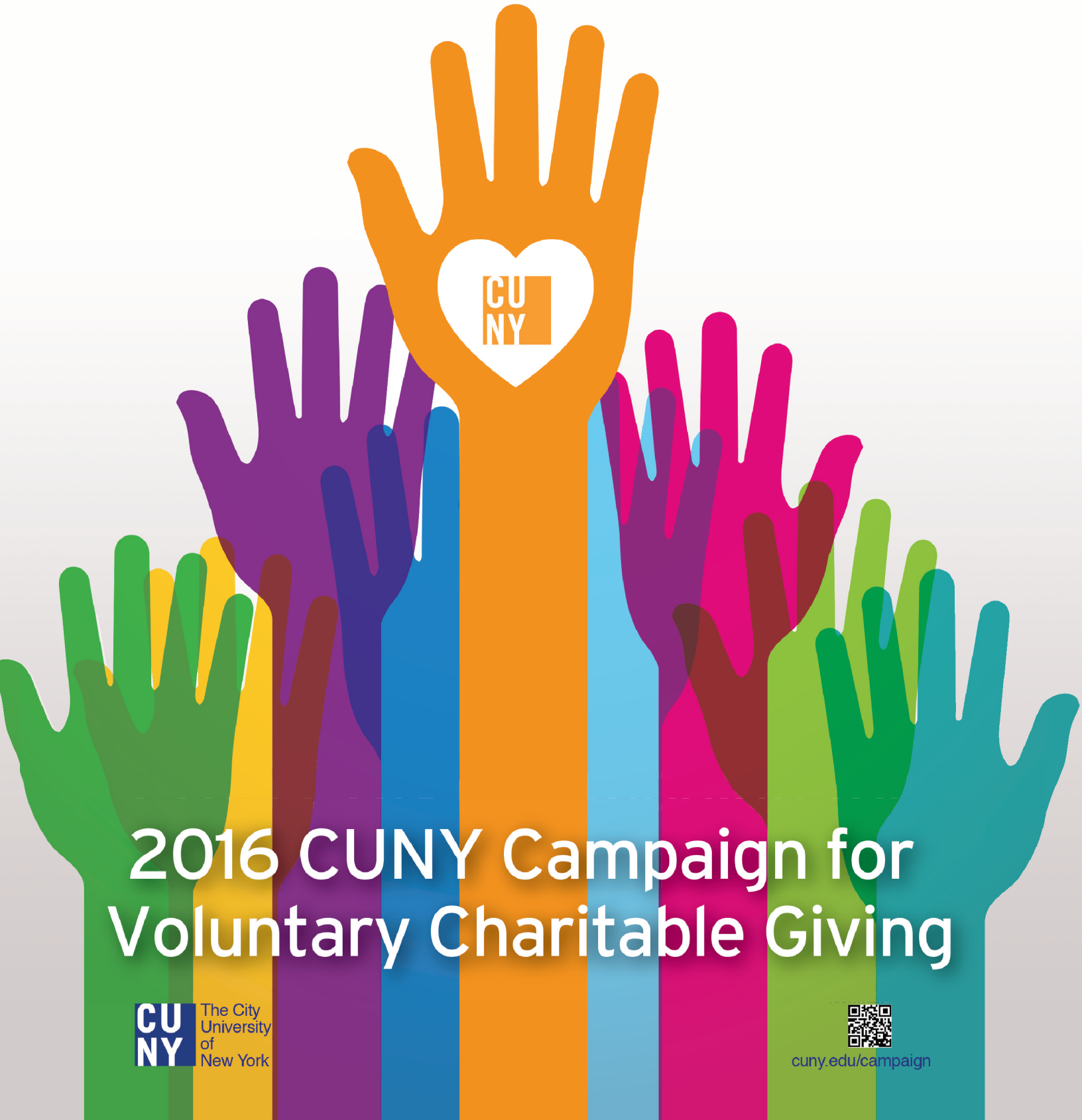

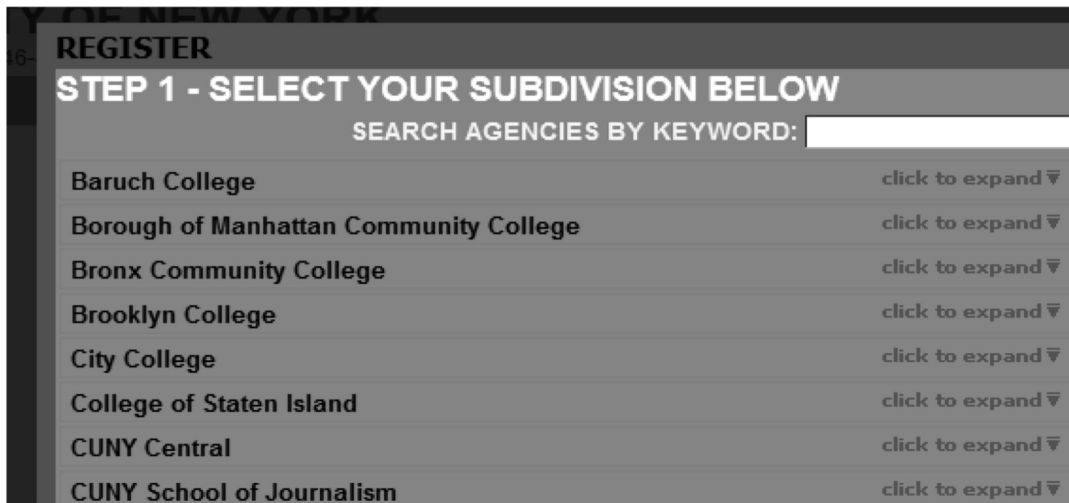

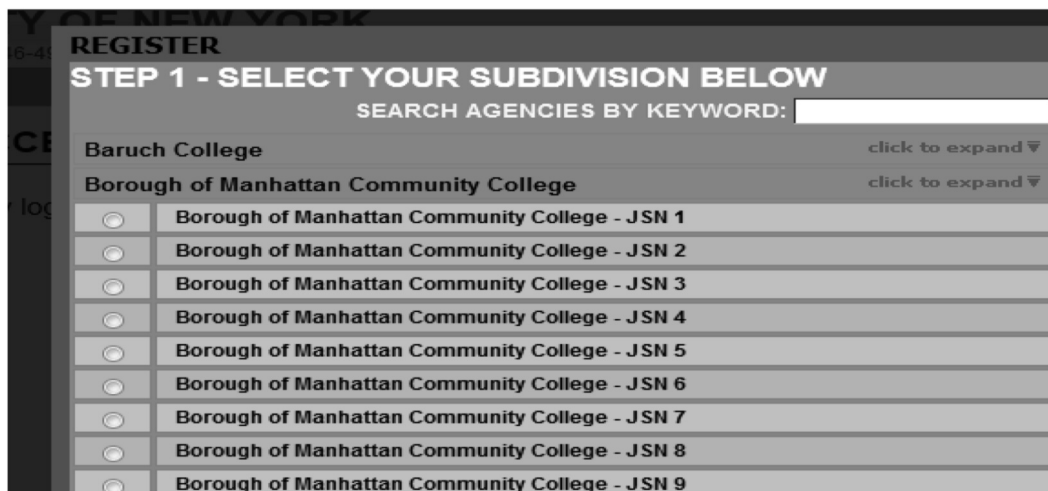

Select your college from the list. Use the key word search to narrow the list.
