The Demolition of Brookdale

On October 13, 2022, Mayor Adams and Governor Hochul unveiled plans for the Science Park and Research Campus (SPARC) in Kips Bay. SPARC will create a single campus for scientific research and the healthcare workforce with space for the DOE, CUNY, health and biotech companies, and public health institutions. SPARC will be built on what is currently Hunter's Brookdale Campus, so Hunter College will be losing its only affordable dorm option in the coming years.

Alongside the creation of SPARC, CUNY has released no information on the timeline of this project OR how they plan to make up for the potential loss of a home for hundreds of students. Where will these students go? What other alternative and affordable solutions are there? When will dorms stop being available? Nothing has been clarified with the main stakeholders here: Hunter College students.

The CUNY Board of Trustees holds public borough hearings to receive testimony and statements from concerned individuals about university issues. The next meeting is on Monday, October 17th at 4:30 PM at the CUNY Graduate Center in the Baisley Powell Elebash Recital Hall (1st Floor Lobby). As students, we need to mobilize. Please show up, please speak up, we need ALL the help we can get to demand answers from CUNY. Speaking is not mandatory. If you simply want to attend, that is also very important. There is power in numbers!

Requirements:


- Can be an undergraduate student OR graduate. Preference will be given to individuals (usually graduates) who can do 9AM-5PM
