COVID Protocols for In-Person Attendance:

The National Center is working with the NYC Seminar and Conference Center on safety protocols for in-person conference participation and will continue to monitor recommendations from the CDC, WHO, and local health officials. Please see the <u>NYC Department of Health</u> <u>COVID webpage</u>.

All in-person participants at the 2022 Annual Conference, whether a presenter, attendee, staff, guest, or vendor will be required to be fully vaccinated. As part of conference registration for inperson conference participation you must <u>submit</u> vaccination documentation. If you are not able to meet the vaccination requirement, please register for virtual participation.

All in-person participants at the National Center event will be <u>required to wear masks</u> at all times during the event except while <u>actively</u> eating/drinking, presenting, or in an outdoor venue where individuals can be physically distant. Masks must cover both the mouth and nose. We ask that participants honor the requests of others to mask up and/or maintain physical distancing.

If public health guidelines prevent the holding of an in-person event in April, the conference will be held as virtual-only. In that case, registration fees paid for in-person registration fees will be applied to the National Center's 2023 annual conference or other events.
