



Pre-Health Professions Advising Pathways

Pre-Health is not a specific major, but pre-professional healthcare career tracks. Offering access to many professional development opportunities, resources, and tools, the Pre-Health Professions Pathways program prepares students for admission into health professions graduate programs, including medical, dental, optometry, podiatry, and veterinary programs, and allied health programs such as pharmacy, physician assistant, physical and occupational therapy.

Pre-Health Professions Advising Pathways Program Admission Requirements

- † Join the Pre-Med listserv- <https://hunter.listserv.cuny.edu/Scripts/wa-hc.exe?SUBED1=PREMEDINFO-L&A=1>.
- † Attend the Pre-Health New Student Orientation for freshman and transfer students.
- † Enroll in **PPAP 1000- Building your Pre-Health Credentials Portfolio**. This is a seminar series, which meets on Wednesdays from 1:10PM-3:00PM, which includes various topics to help you develop your Pre-Health Credentials Portfolio and the core competencies each pre-health professions students must achieve before entering graduate school.
 - You will receive the link to register after attending the Pre-Health New Student orientation. If you have a class at this time, we recommend that you register for the seminar series in the following semester. Please note, if you miss a seminar you will be required to attend the seminar you missed in the following semester.
- † Complete at least 12 credits from the list of prerequisite Biology or Chemistry /Physics course requirements.
- † Have at least a 3.3 GPA in science courses taken at Hunter College.
- † Attendance policy -You must attend all sessions in their entirety. If you leave before the session ends, you will be marked as absent.
- † Enroll in PPAP 1002- Healthcare Careers Exploration upon completion of PPAP 1000 in the spring semester. You will receive the link to register after completion of PPAP 1000
- † Upon completion of PPAP 1000 and PPAP 1002, you must schedule an appointment with Robert Hieger (appointment) to review your Pre-Health application and to open your Pre-Health file.
