
**Meeting of the Hunter College Senate

	WHEREAS, the adjunct faculty members of Hunter College and the other senior colleges of CUNY will not be paid until the October 14, 1993 pay period; and	14 15 16
	WHEREAS, adjunct faculty are an important and highly valued segment of our academic community; and	17 18
	WHEREAS, there has not been adequate planning for alleviating the personal hardships that must follow from not receiving a paycheck for the first six weeks of the semester; therefore,	19 20 21
	BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hunter College Senate expresses its outrage that adjunct faculty are not being paid until six weeks after the beginning of the semester and urges the Central Administration of the City University and the Professional Staff Congress, CUNY to take steps to pay adjunct faculty before the October 14, 1993 pay period or to provide interest-free advances to adjuncts; and	22 23 24 25 26 27
	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Hunter College Senate urge the Central Administration and PSC, CUNY to guarantee that such an iniquitous situation does not reoccur; and	28 29 30
	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Central Administration and the PSC, CUNY provide an explanation to the Hunter College Senate of the reasons for the delay in issuing paychecks to adjunct faculty; and	31 32 33
	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Central Administration of CUNY and the PSC/CUNY inform the Hunter College Senate of the steps to be taken to prevent the recurrence of prolonged delays in issuing paychecks to adjunct faculty; and	34 35 36 37
