Meeting of the Hunter College Senate
2 May 1990

1 The 253rd meeting of the Hunter College Senate was convened at 4:25 p.m. in
2 Room W714.

Presiding: Jo Kirsch, Chair

4 **Attendance:** The elected members of the Senate, with the exception of those listed in Ap-
5 pendix I.

6 **Report by the President:** The report was postponed to the next meeting.

7 **Report by the Administrative Committee:** Prof. Kirsch presented the report as follows;

8 Approved Curriculum Changes
9 The following curriculum changes, as listed in Parts I, II, and III of the report
10 dated 2 May 1990, were approved as per Senate resolution and were submitted
11 for the Senate's information: Items UR-753 (Sociology), UR-756 (Physics), UR-
12 757 (Theatre & Film), UR-758 (Music), UR-759 (Romance Languages), UR760
13 (German), US-746 (Art), US-748 (Romance Languages), US-749 (Classics/Russi-
14 an), US-747 (Philosophy), GS-305 (Economics), GS-307 (Theatre & Film), GS-308,
15 GS-314, GS-315 (Curriculum&Teaching/Educational Foundations), GS-309 (Cur-
16 riculum & Teaching/Educational Foundations/English).

17 **Teacher Evaluations Committee**
18 Mr. Cecil Mark, Chair of the Committee, presented the report dated 18 April
19 1990, recommending approval of the "Clinical Form" for use in clinical and lab
20 courses in the Nursing Program. He informed the Senate that a pilot form, to-
21 gether with the standard teacher evaluation form, was used in eight sections of
22 clinical nursing courses in Spring 1989. The pilot form was well received by both
23 clinical nursing faculty and students. After some editorial revisions were made,
24 the "Clinical Form" was approved by the faculty of the School of Nursing on 4
25 April 1990. It is now submitted for Senate approval.

26 The motion to approve the "Clinical Form" (see Appendix II) for use in clinical
27 and lab courses in the nursing program carried unanimously by hand vote.

28 **Undergraduate Academic Requirements Committee re: CR/NC Grading System**
29 Prof. Kirsch presented the Committee's report dated 2 May 1990. She recom-
30 mended that the Senate resolve itself into a "Committee-of-the-Whole" to con-
31 sider the report and to provide direction for further action by the Undergraduate
32 Academic Requirements Committee.

33 The motion to go into a Committee-of-the-Whole was approved by voice vote.
34 Prof. Sam Korn was appointed to Chair the Committee.

35 The Committee-of-the-Whole rose at 5:40 p.m.

36 A motion to adjourn carried and the meeting was adjourned at 5:40 p.m.
