 13 **Committee** **Undergraduate Course of Study Committee**
 14 **Report:** The Vice Chair called on the Chair of the Undergraduate Course of Study Committee, Professor
 15 Eckhard Khun-Osius. Below is a summary statement of his report. He said:
 16
 17 “Guidelines for submitting proposals for review for the new common core have been provided by
 18 the committee. These guidelines include the steps, a timeline, and templates. Departments may
 19 choose what category or buckets they want to place their courses. Keep in mind that some
 20 categories are restricted, such as the Required Core. The committee won’t override the
 21 departments’ placements of courses in Buckets. However, the committee will recommend that the
 22 department reconsidered their placement of courses if they see a disparity between buckets. The
 23 committee’s main task is to make sure the syllabi match the Learning Outcomes found in the
 24 CUNY Common Core forms. The Guidelines, Forms, and samples can be found in the Hunter
